

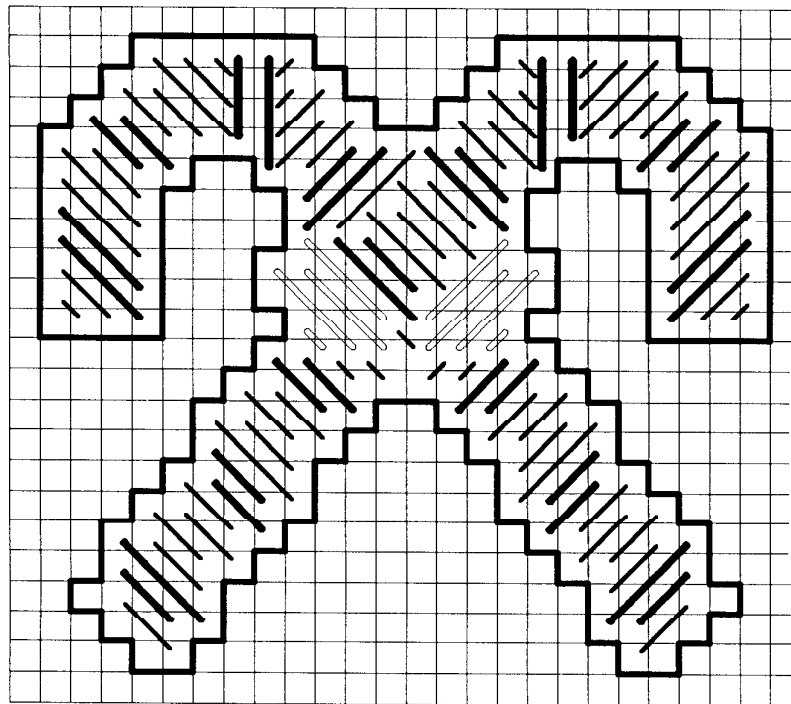
CROSSED CANDY CANES ORNAMENT^{©1992}

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS (for one two-sided ornament):

2-4' x 4' square pieces—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
#16 Tapestry Needle
Plastic Canvas Metallic Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
7 yds—#5 Christmas Red
5 yds—#10 White Pearl
2 yds—#4 Christmas Green

2—5mm Ruby Faceted Gemstones from The Beadery
Glue Gun (Crafty Magic Melt Low Temperature Glue
Gun from Ad Tech used in this project.

**Add sparkle to your holidays with these stunning metallic ornaments.
Decorate your home, and share with your friends as special gifts.**

1. Cut two pieces of canvas (24 holes x 21 holes) and trim according to dark outer lines of pattern, making two identical pieces for each ornament.
2. Work all areas in Slanting Gobelin Stitch as indicated on chart, being careful so that the yarn does not twist but lays flat on the canvas. Weave in all ends securely on the back side.
3. Place the two stitched pieces back to back and sew together using the Overcast Stitch. Use **Green** (#4) yarn around the two holly leaf areas and **Red** (#5) around the candy cane edges.
4. Cut an 8" length of White Pearl (#10) yarn, form into a loop and sew or glue to the top back side of the ornament for a hanger. Glue the red gemstones in place for the holly berries in the center and just below both the holly leaves.
