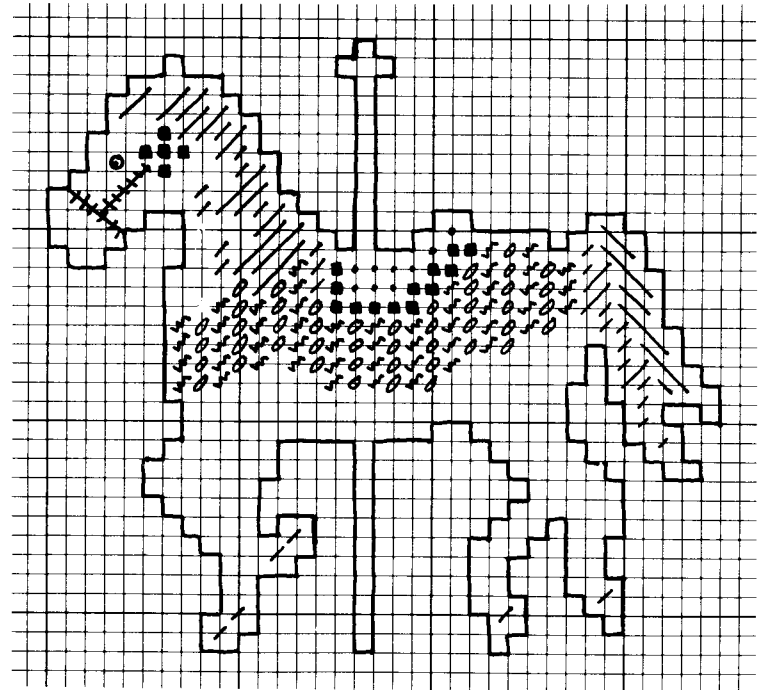








Carousel Horse Ornament

Materials: 1/4 sheet #7 plastic canvas: cut 1 piece 35 holes x 32 holes – trim according to pattern. **Yarn:** #1 Bright Gold-4 yds., #8 Pink-1 yd., #13 Fuchsia-2 yds., #14 Light Blue-2 yds., #15 Purple-2 yds., White worsted weight yarn-5 yds. **Other:** 3 tiny gold ribbon roses

Stitching: Work mane, tail and hooves in Continental and Long Straight Stitches noting the direction of the stitches. Overcast adjacent edges at the same time to conserve yarn. Work other metallic areas in Continental or Cross Stitch as indicated on the chart, overcasting adjacent edges at the same time and using Light Blue and Purple for the blanket area. Overcast the pole using Fuchsia. Work remaining areas in White worsted weight yarn and the Continental Stitch, overcasting adjacent edges at the same time. Make a Bright Gold French Knot for the eye. With the pink yarn take straight stitches for bridle, working clear around the canvas edge and anchoring on the back side.

Glue the tiny ribbon roses in place, referring to the photo for placement. Cut a piece of Bright Gold yarn 8" long, form a loop and glue to the top back side of the pole for a hanger.
