

JEWELLED SNOWFLAKE ORNAMENT^{©1991}

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

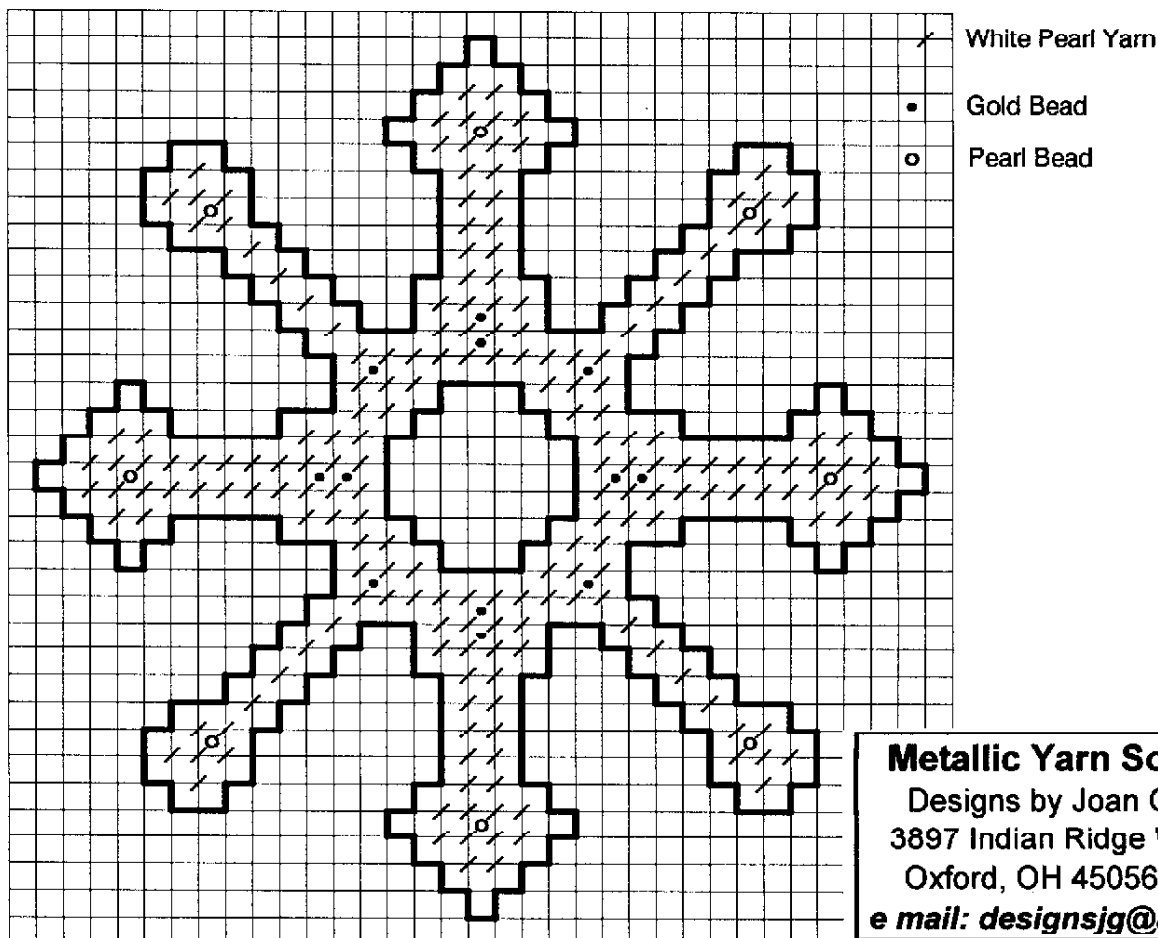
MATERIALS (for one two-sided ornament):

2- 5½" square pieces – #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas;
#16 Tapestry Needle
Plastic Canvas Metallic Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
12 yds – #10 White Pearl
1 yd – #1 Gold

24 – 3mm Gold Beads
16 – 5mm Pearl Beads
White embroidery floss or sewing thread
#24 Tapestry Needle (for beads)

Sparkling White Pearl metallic gives your snowflake an icy glister!
Make several for holiday decorations, tree ornaments or party gifts.

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1. Cut two pieces of canvas (33 holes x 33 holes) and trim according to dark outer lines of pattern, making two identical pieces for each ornament. Using a craft knife or manicure scissors, cut out the center opening on each snowflake.
2. Work both snowflakes in Half Cross Stitch using White Pearl (#10) yarn.
3. Using the sewing thread (or 2 of the 6 strands of embroidery floss) attach the beads where indicated on chart in the following manner. Knot thread ends and weave in and out of several stitches on the back side to further secure the beadwork. Bring the needle up at point indicated on chart, slip the bead on the needle and insert the needle back into the same hole to attach each bead. Weave the thread up and down the arms of the snowflakes to conceal the thread when moving from one point to another.
4. Place the two snowflakes back to back, sew outer edges together using White Pearl (#10) yarn and the Overcast Stitch. Overcast the inner hole using the Gold (#1) yarn. Attach a thread or floss hanger at the top of one of the points.
