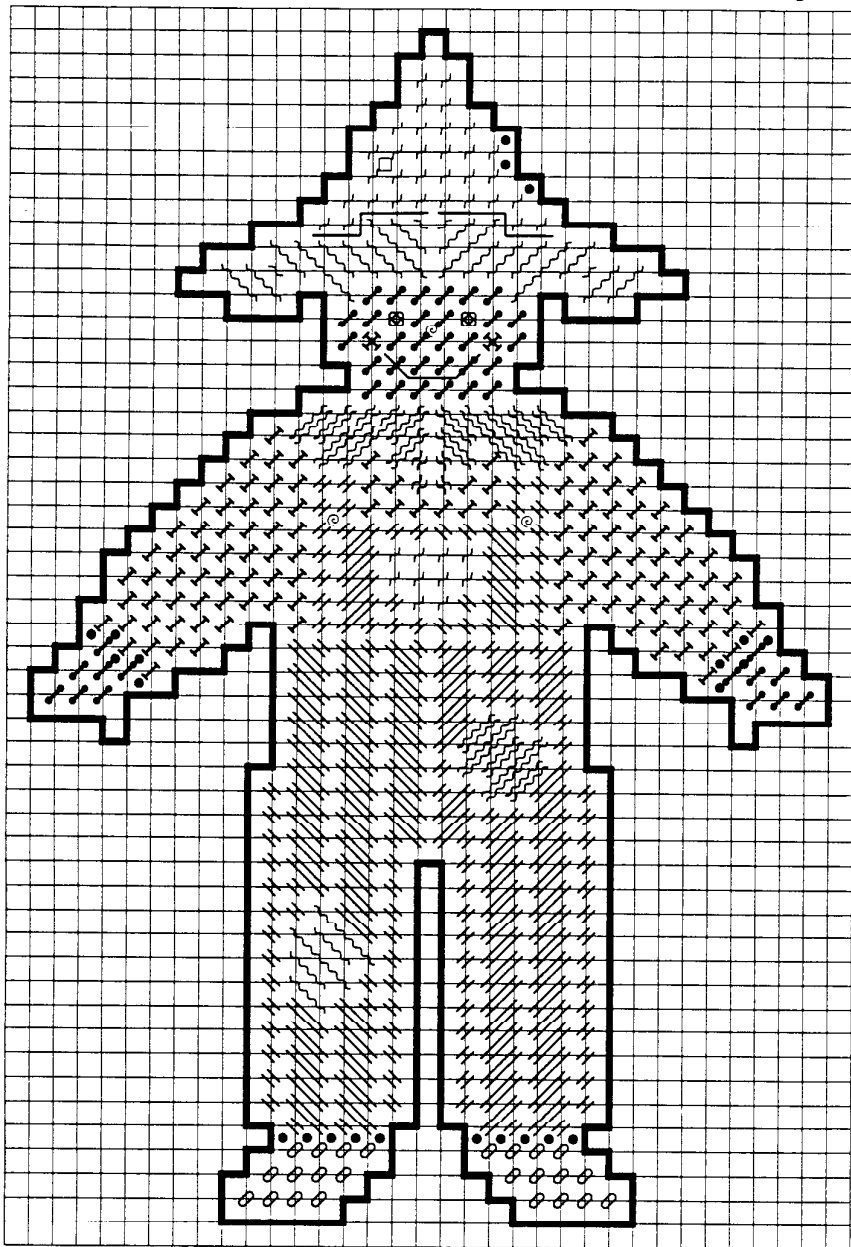
A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS

1/4 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
 #16 Tapestry Needle
 Worsted weight yarn
 6 yds—Denim Blue
 2 yds—Pale Flesh
 9"—Black

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
 5 yds—PC7 Yellow Gold
 4 yds—PC5 Red
 3 yds—PC3 Copper
 3 yds—PC21 Bronze

Decorative Ceramic Button—Mill Hill #86069 (sunflower)
 Sewing needle, brown sewing thread or floss



1. Cut one piece, 33 holes x 50 holes, and trim according to dark outer lines of chart.
2. Work the following areas in Continental Stitch—top of hat, face, hands, shirt, shoes, bib pocket; Slanting Gobelin—overalls (note direction of stitches); Varying Diagonal Stitches (note direction of stitches)—hat brim, collar, patches; Cross Stitch—eyes, cheeks; French Knots—overall buttons (PC21); Backstitch—top of hat brim. To make nose and mouth, separate black yarn to 2 plies and make a French Knot for the nose and backstitch the mouth. Overcast all edges with the color adjacent, using Bronze for the hat.
3. Make "straw" as follows: Using Gold yarn weave in on the back side and bring yarn forward at each tiny dot; clip yarn about 3/4" long (vary slightly for ragged look). continue for each tiny dot at wrists, ankles and hat edge.
4. Using the sewing needle and brown sewing thread or floss, attach the sunflower button to the hat at the tiny square.
